

Reorganization & Changes in MQM USA

Nigraan e Aala MQM North America Dr. Khalid Maqbool Siddiqui has announced reorganization and changes in MQM USA's central organizational structure and in some units of MQM USA. The announcement was made in the 6th Semi-Annual Convention of MQM USA at San Francisco on February 23rd, 2008. This reorganization and changes, though for an interim period, would be effective immediately, and is as follows:

- Ex-Central Organizer Ibad Rehman will be Nigraan of MQM USA.
- Members Central Helping Committee, Junaid Fahmi and Asad Siddiqui, and MQM Atlanta Unit Incharge Nadeem Siddiqui have been appointed Members, Central Organizing Committee.
- The Central Helping Committee has also been revised. Asif Qazi from Detroit, Major Najmi from Houston, Anwar Ahmed from New York, Saeed Khan from California, Irshad Kamali from Dallas, and Kamran Haider from Richmond have been appointed members of this committee.
- Member Central Organizing Committee, Arshad Hussain will be in-charge of MQF while Member Central Helping Committee Kamran Haider will be the Joint In-charge.
- The ex-in-charge of MQF Huda Khan will be Secretary, Political Action Committee.
- Member Central Organizing Committee Asad Siddiqui will be in-charge of Media Cell of MQM USA, while Member Central Helping Committee Anwar Ahmed and Fawad Rehman will be the Joint In-charges of Media Cell.
- Member Central Organizing Committee Junaid Fahmi will be the Nigraan of Gahwarah e Adab USA. Member Central Helping Committee Major Najmi will be Joint In-charge of Gahwarah e Adab USA with Rohail Khan as Incharge, Gahwarah e Adab USA.
- In New York, the Joint In-charge MQM New York Unit, Anjum Arif has been appointed In-charge, MQM New York Unit, while Khursheed ul Haque and Asma Rohail have been appointed Joint In-charges.
- In Atlanta, Joint Unit In-charge Saquib Mohiuddin has been appointed In-charge MQM Atlanta Unit while Mohammad Haseeb Khan as Joint In-charge.
- In Houston, Jamshed Warsi has been appointed In-charge MQM Houston Unit while Mohammad Zaheer will be the Nigraan of the Houston Unit.

- With this reorganization and changes, The Central Advisory Committee has also been dissolved.
