The same is the position of the nations, and groups of the world. - 1) Regional conflicts are a great danger for world peace.
- 2) The desire of getting supremacy above the other has become the source of instability in the world. Such psychology is shown by the extremists in the ranks of religious & political organizations.
- 3) Less facilitated nation in respect of education and health are always ready for agitation and violent action.

- 4) Economically less advanced or the under developed countries are always facing civil war situation within their countries. They are the big exporters of violence in other countries.
- 5) Human resources are mishandled and are shifted from the less gifted to the most advanced ones.
- 6) Injustice is one of the main reasons of violence and threat to universal peace.
- 7) Freedom movements and people seeking their rights are not taken and handled in the right way and the people fighting these wars are labeled as traitors and outlaws and treated and dealt with as criminals.
- 8) Corruption is also a major reason for violence.

Eleven September's vicious incident has shaken the whole world. A person residing in remote area of world, and even Bedouin has also felt the minus effects of this great incident of the 21st century. This incident has made us realize the fact that we are lacking tolerance, and increasing hatred for each other, as an individual or as a nation.

We are committed to keep and maintain peace in the world, so that we may be able to transfer our skills to our next generation for their prosperity and for the future peace. Many steps can be, and should be taken in this context.

- 1) Muslims, one fourth of the whole population of the world, are religiously bound committed to make this world a peaceful society, by acting upon the teachings of the Holy Prophet delivered in his last sermon at Hajja-tul-Widah.
 - a) So, called root causes of Muslim fundamentalism be checked and rectified, whether linguistic or sectarian.
 - b) World must give due share of its authority to the Muslim communities. An example is composition of Security Council, which has no Muslim country as its permanent member.
 - c) Muslim countries should join hands with each other, not for the purpose of aggression or war, but to make them strong, intellectually, economically and socially, so that their combined strength becomes at par with the developed countries.
- 2) India as a big power and thickly populated and resourceful country should make friendship with her neighboring countries to make South Asian Region a peaceful part of the world.
- 3) Pakistan is Totalitarianism State. In the context of corruption some secret agencies (ISI and other) distributed the foreign aid into the religious extremist and corrupt politicians and feudal lords, they are the big exporters of violence in other countries and their patronized criminal gangs, terrorists groups and religious militants to harass, intimidate and kill the MQM leaders office bears, workers, Ex. Members National & provincial Assembly, nominated candidates, supporters and relative, all the above act in this country which looks like "vice rule where God reign".

- 4) The U.N. world organization should consider the right demands of the deprived nation of the world. Precautionary measures should be adopted in the troubled areas of the world. In justice with any nation cab is threat to peace of the world, as reaction can be shown in a violent way. The U.N. should decide and study the cases impartially. Otherwise it will meet the same fate as the league of nation.
- 5) Regional conflicts may be resolved by mutual understanding or by intervening by the world leaders, before the situation goes out of control and becomes explosive.
- 6) By improving badly affected economic conditions of the under develop countries, peace can be ensured in the world.
- 7) The more education and health facilities extended to the have-not countries will help in keeping peace.
- 8) Religious leaders or the clergymen of all the religious should have a forum to keep harmony among the followers of different religions. They can also be made bound to keep the extremists in their limits.
- 9) Freedom movements and violators should be distinguished. The economically weak governments should be aided to overcome their problems.
- 10) There should be complete ban on Nuclear Tests. And the present nuclear devices should be destroyed gradually to keep peace in the world.
- 11) Last of all the desire to have supremacy over the others is the big obstruction in keeping the peace.

Each and every individual and the nations of the world must realize that peace can not be imposed from outside. It is some thing which develops from inside, and until and unless, the problems of the people of the world are not addressed properly, like food, shelter, education, medical treatment and protection against oppression, peace in terms of 'Local' or peace in term of 'International' context can not be observed. **END//.**
