1) TANZEEMI WRITTEN TEST

A 40 minutes test consisting 40 questions related to:

1. *Tanzeemi* Affairs (60%) covering Life of *Quaid-e-Tehrik Altaf Hussain*, MQM history, purpose, struggle, *sanihats* (tragedies), imprisonments, elections, governments, parliamentary diplomacy, achievements, developments, and KKF
2. Pakistani Affairs (20%) covering system of government, political history, political parties, army rules, and assassinations
3. International Affairs (20%) UNO, super power, revolutionary movements, world renowned leaders, World organizations effecting global politics, and world's economy

Note: This test is not the selection criteria of any sort. The purpose of conducting this test is to provide equal opportunity to the participants to discover their hidden potential & talent which can be used for *Tanzeem*. Three top scoring participants from MQM Canada and three top scoring participants from MQM USA will be selected to participate in a talk show.

2) TALK SHOW

Total Duration will be 1 hour. Each participant will be given 10 minutes; each participant will be tested separately. A total of 8 questions will be asked, out of which 6 questions will be the same and 2 questions will be different. A panel of judges will judge the performance base on the knowledge of subject personality, presentation, style, confidence, language ability, posture and their body language. Apart from judges, the audience (workers) will also monitor performances on the same criteria.

A scoring rubric has been designed on the above criteria to judge individual performances, which will be provided to the judges' panel and the audience (workers) before the talk show.

The winner will be announced on the cumulative results received from the judges and the audience. There will be two winners (1 from Canada and USA each) and they will be awarded trophies.

3) OPEN FORUM

(On MQM North America, Challenges & Solution)

The above topic should be communicated in advance to all units through their in-charges so that Sathies come prepared to participate in the discussion. Each speaker will be given 2 minutes.
