

“The Fall Of Dhaka” Was A Mere Reflection Of Feudal Attitude And Mentality: Muttahida Quami Movement, USA



Media Cell, MQM USA; New York; December 16, 2008: The Central Organizer MQM USA, Ajaz Siddiqui and the members of The Central Organizing Committee declared “The Dhaka Fall” of December 16, 1971 as a mere reflection of the feudal mentality and attitude of the politicians and the people in the power corridors in the then Pakistan. In a statement issued today to commemorate the bitter remembrance of the incidence of the split of Pakistan today in 1971, the office bearers of MQM USA said that sixty plus years old history of Pakistan is quite self-elaborative with the presence of these type of ugly incidences, such as

the Dhaka Fall, that the feudal lords, and people with feudal mentality never allowed equality to prevail among the people of Pakistan and whenever people demanded their due rights, they were either punished with separation, or the life was made suffocating for them. They said that the Dhaka Fall is also a stigma on all those political parties who were in Pakistan at that time and did not resist the split and rather allowed and facilitated the process. The office bearers of MQM USA further said this had been the dilemma of Pakistani people and the Pakistani politics that the power corridors had always been occupied, directly or indirectly, by the politicians and people who had feudal attitude and mentality and the political science has proved, during the course of time, a long while ago that feudalism and the democracy cannot prosper together and one of these systems has to take the exit and unfortunately in Pakistan feudal system always remained in keeping the democracy out. They said that the geography of our beloved country was changed only to satisfy the power hunger denying the due rights of the people and the denial of the due rights of the people always creates unrest and distaste among the people and the flood of unrest and distaste more often than not wipes out the boundaries and geography of the countries and empires. They requested the politicians of the country to play their role sensibly, keeping off of the extremists, fundamentalists, and religious fanatics, as well as the so-called opportunistic politicians and their parties, as the country is still facing the same dangers of disruption consequent to the denial of the basic rights of the people of Pakistan. They further said that the MQM and its workers have the resolve of keeping the integrity of the country intact and will eventually succeed in forcing the feudal system to take the exit and then the 98% oppressed will prevail.
