

## **Problems Of People Should Be Solved On Priority Basis: Haq Parast Assembly Members Demand**

Karachi, October 30, 2007: Haq Parast member National Assembly from Muttahida Quami Movement, Capt. (R) Akhlaque Hussain, and member Provincial Assembly Sindh, Akhter Bilgrami met with the Executive Officer of Karachi Cantonment Board, Naeem Jan, in his office, and apprised him of the non-availability of the basic necessities and the provisions for the people, and the difficulties faced by the people in Karachi Cantonment, and demanded of the solution of those problems on the priority basis. Haq Parast members said, while talking to Naeem Jan, that for the last 8 years Cantonment Board is awarding rewards to only those people who are in their good books, and even the election for the councilors are not being held, and due to these falloffs, people, living in the area of the Cantonment Board are facing extreme difficulties in getting their day-to-day problems solved. They also directed the attention of Naeem Jan to the sewerage and water supply, defective system of removal of garbage and cleaning, non-functional street lights on main roads and streets, and demanded that these problems should be given priority in their solutions. They also demanded the renovation of underground tank of Muslim colony, installation of new pump, development of a park and building of another storey in the community center in Bizarata Lane, and purchase and procurement of new machinery so that the people should be able to have the basic necessities of life. At this occasion Naeem Jan listened to the complaints diligently and recommendation from Haq Parast representatives and reassured them of his co-operation for the solution of the problem of the people living in his area.
