### 1. Traveling

If you or your family members are traveling by air, please make the arrangements as soon as possible. It's hard to find good deals on airfares at last minute. Sooner you make reservation, better it is. Once you have your flt. Confirmed, please send us the details as soon as possible.

You have 4 choices for airports. Hotel is almost equidistant from all these locations:

- a. LAX (Los Angeles Airport)
- b. Long Beach Airport
- c. John Wayne Airport, Orange County
- d. Ontario Airport, San Bernardino County

If you are planning to travel by road, we still need information for above items 'a' through 'f' as soon as possible. You can take either Interstate 10, Interstate 40 or Interstate 80 for California. Although we would strongly suggest to carry Thomas Brothers or AAA maps with you. Hotel address is down below.

## **2. Lodging**

Lodging arrangements have been made at Holiday Inn, Buena Park. You can check In on Friday August 1, 2003. Rooms have been reserved for 2 nights on behalf of convention committee. Host unit will be only responsible for room rent. All other services will have to be paid by individual him or herself. If you or your family members are planning to stay over for few more days, you can stay at the same hotel at discounted rates or any other hotel of your choice. *From Interstate 40:*

Take 15 South from Barstow to 91 west (approx. 3 hr. drive from Barstow to 91 Fwy) exit beach blvd.
